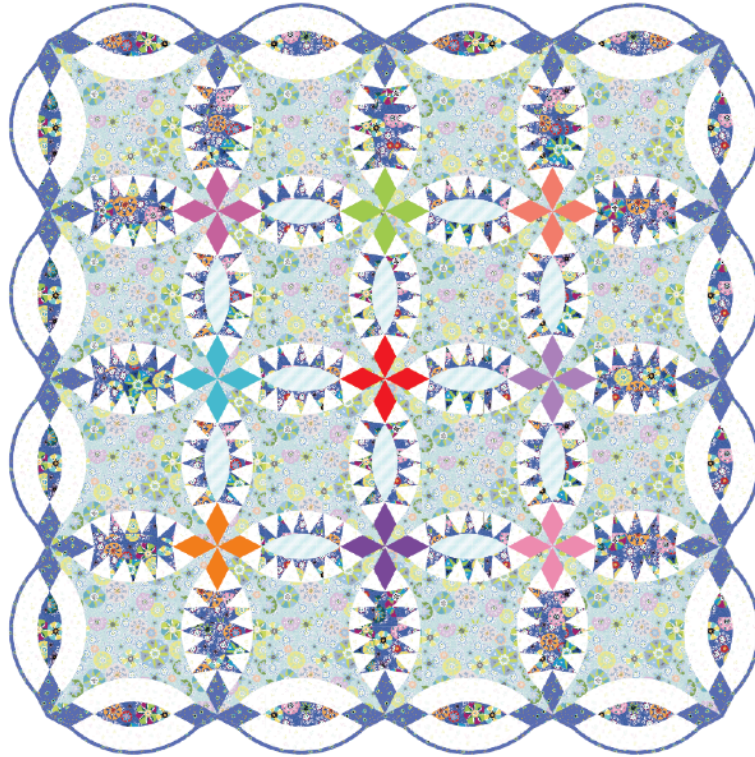

Pickle & Star Double Wedding Ring class (intermediate to advanced)

Learn all the construction techniques for this new classic – the Pickle & Star double wedding ring quilt.

- *curve piecing by machine
- *foundation paper piecing
- *curve piecing with pivot
- *cutting curves with acrylic templates
- *ring construction – including how to line up and keep your star points!
- *row construction
- *shaped binding

This class will focus on a 16-ring (4x4 ring, 57" x 57") layout with the option to make it larger later. Please note: Because this is an advanced class, time in class is spent on construction of the Pickle & Star double wedding ring. Students are asked to keep to this classic/simple layout and size in order to cover all the lessons.

Learn the tricks for ease of construction! I have many tips for piecing the DWR!

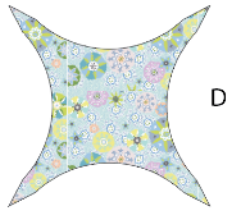

~VFW Quilts Pickle & Star double wedding ring acrylic template set: \$42

~VFW Quilts Pickle & Star arc paper pieces, throw size: \$8

NOTE: The Pickle & Star DWR template shapes are different than a traditional double wedding ring. This set does not work with any other DWR templates.

~Fabric:



Concave Squares D - 2½ yards (template fits on a 14"x14" square)



Small Melons A – inner rings – 1/4 yd



Small Melons A – outer rings & Arc Points F – 2 yards



Solid Arcs B & Arc Point Backgrounds E – 2 1/2 yards



Diamonds C – outer rings – 1/2 yard



**Diamonds C – inner rings – 3"x18" strip each of 9 fabrics
or 1/2 yard combined**



Additional fabric not needed for class: 1/2 to 5/8 yard fabric for binding this size quilt.

~Sewing machine, cord and foot pedal

~1/4" sewing machine foot without a metal guide

~rotary cutters: **28mm size** (this is the size needed for cutting curves)

~cutting mat (optional, if you want one at your station)

~Thread, Scissors, Pins and all your basic sewing equipment.
